What to do if you're being bullied:



What we have learned about bullying:

- ✓ The difference between the four types of bullying: physical, verbal, social, and cyber.
- ✓ Compared between being rude, being mean, and bullying.
- ✓ Bystanders join the bullying if students: don't do anything to help stop the bullying, or if they laugh and encourage the person who is bullying.
- ✓ You can be an **Upstander** by:
 - ~Being a buddy!
 - ~Interrupt the bullying!
 - ~Speak out and tell someone!
 - ~Follow the Six Pillars and be a Good Character!

STOP: Give hand signal and verbal cue to stop and interrupt.

WALK: Walk away.

TALK: Report to an adult at school.

It is a crime for any person to harass another person and includes harassment done via electronic means (such as telephone, the Internet, social media sites, texting, email, instant messages, or other similar means). **Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 13-2921.**
